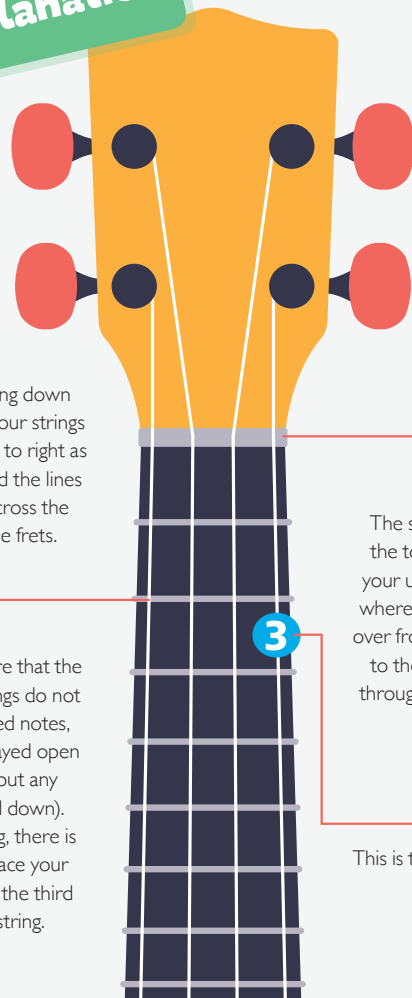

READING THE CHORDS

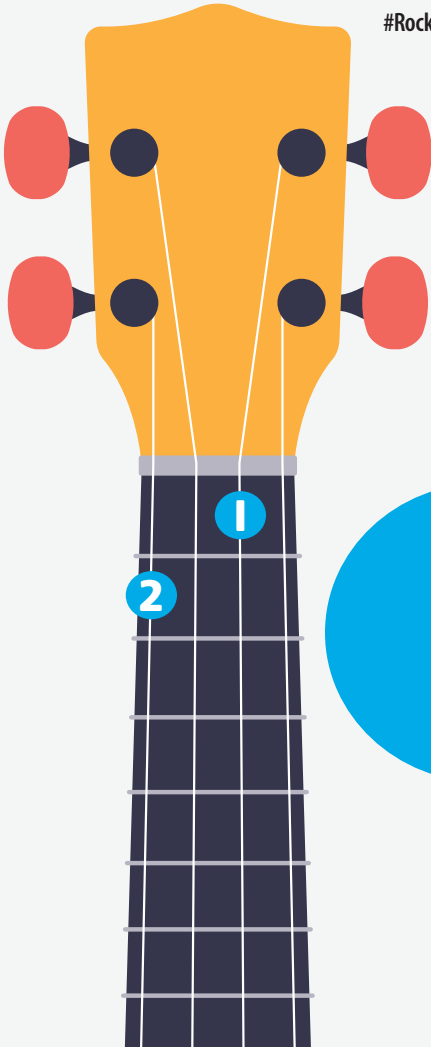


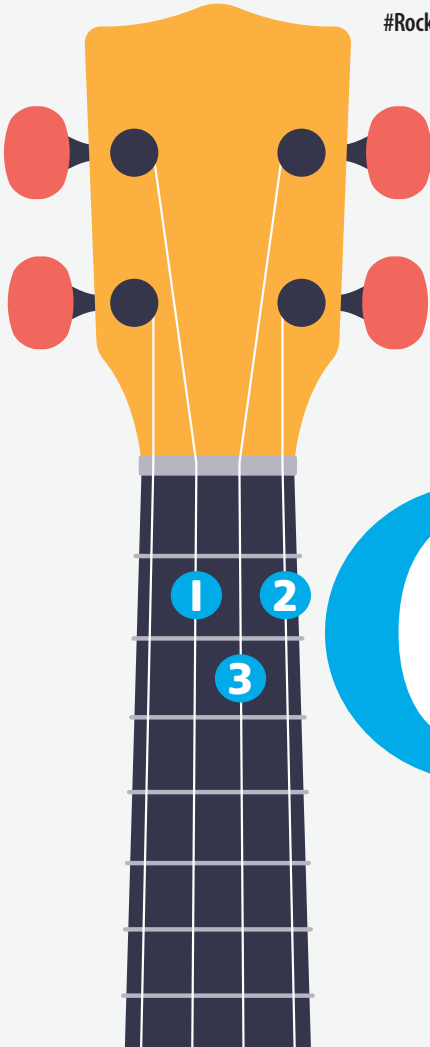
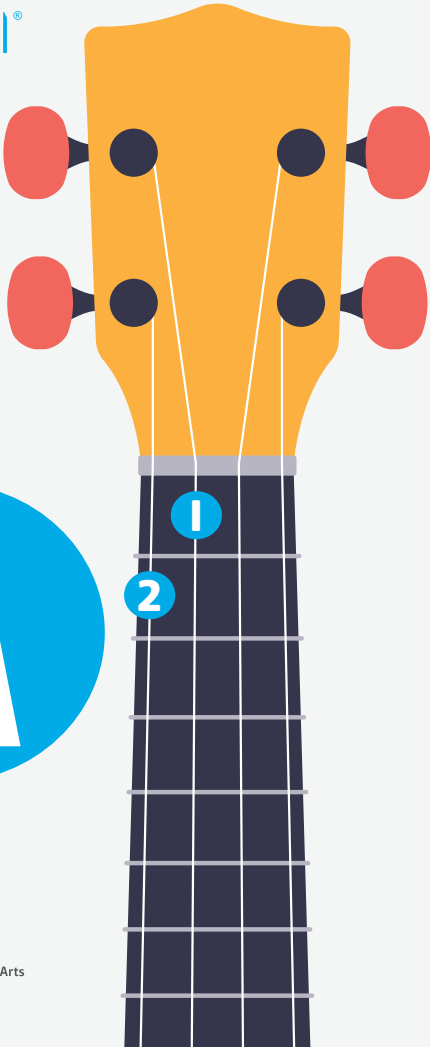
The lines going down the page are your strings (read from left to right as G, C, E, A) and the lines horizontal across the neck are the frets.

You can see here that the G, C and E strings do not have any fretted notes, they are just played open (played without any notes pressed down). On the A string, there is directive to place your third finger on the third fret of this string.

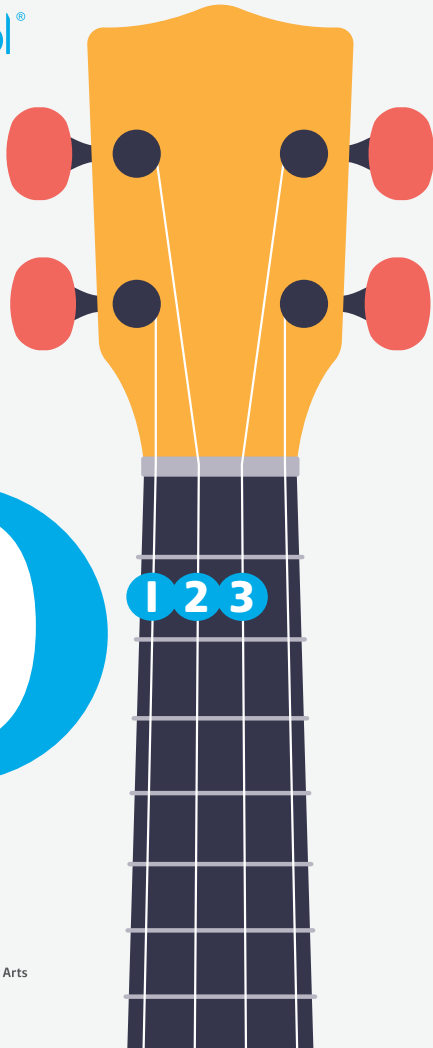
The solid grey line at the top is the nut on your ukulele, the point where the strings cross over from the headstock to the fretboard and through the plastic nut.

This is the chord of **C**



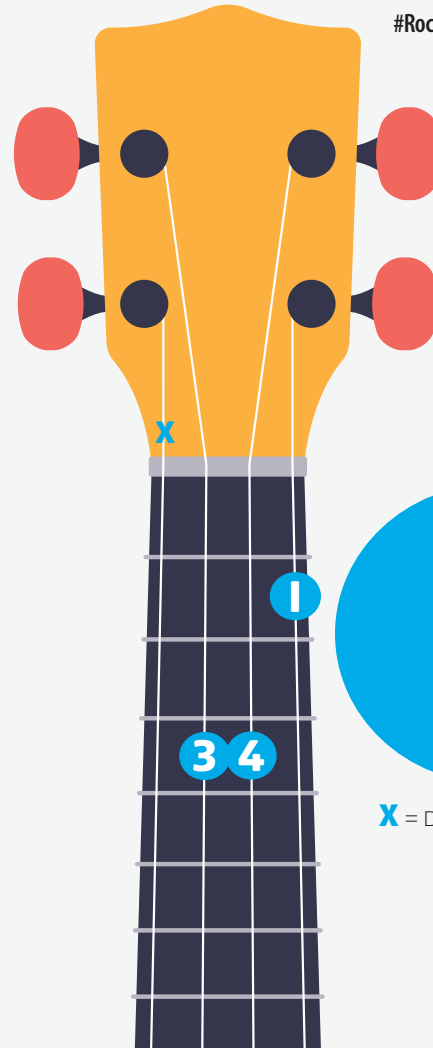

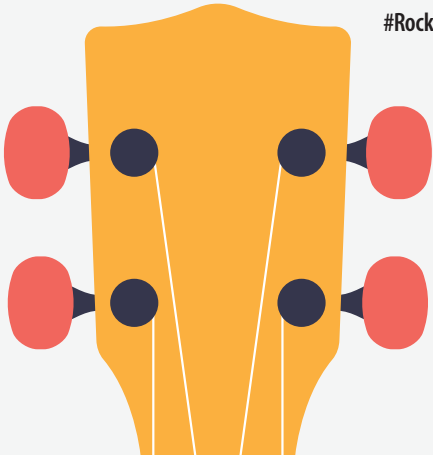

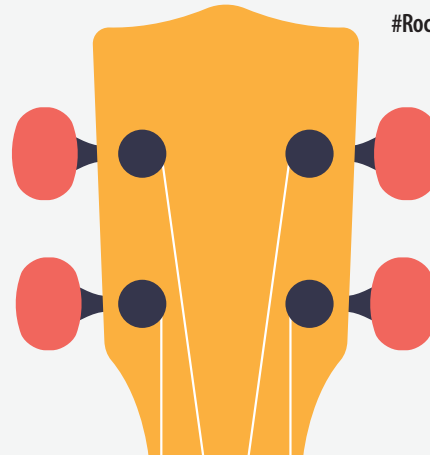
